

Shore power Clean and quiet



What is shore power?

A vessel is supplied with electricity from shore while being towed to a mooring place, so that the vessel's generators do not have to remain in operation to provide energy.

This avoids noise and emissions for the crew on board and for neighbours. It also makes inland navigation even more environmentally friendly!

We are currently testing shore power at several terminals – so the consumption of electricity is free of charge.

Shore power is currently available at these public mooring places in Austria

Status November 2024



The use of shore power is mandatory after 60 minutes of mooring!

According to the Austrian Waterways Traffic Regulations, the use of on-board generators for power supply is prohibited after one hour of mooring at public moorings equipped with shore power supply.
